

Grants for 2016

Malcolm Traill History + Heritage —

to design walking tours to interpret Albany's history and heritage places using actors and musicians to illustrate the stories attached to sites and buildings.

North Midlands Project in partnership with the Carnamah Historical Society & Museum —

to create an education resource for primary schools, in hardcopy and for free download online, on Frank Thomas, bushranger.

Rail Heritage WA —

to assist the publication of a book, *Memories of the Trans-Australian Railway*, marking the Centenary of the completion of the Trans Australian Railway linking Western Australia to the rest of Australia.

St Marys Cathedral Perth Parish —

to support the archival research component of the project to develop the St Mary's Community Museum and Gallery Space located under St Mary's Cathedral in Victoria Square. The new spaces are designated to tell the social history of the site and its connection to the State's history – with photographic exhibitions, interpretative panelling, a timeline graphic, audio visual elements and a display area for museum objects.

Rotary Club of Fremantle —

to digitise its records which begin with the Club's foundation in 1928 and include minutes of the board, annual reports, newsletters, correspondence as well as a large collection of photographs. Fremantle City Library History Centre, providing its service in kind, manages the project.
